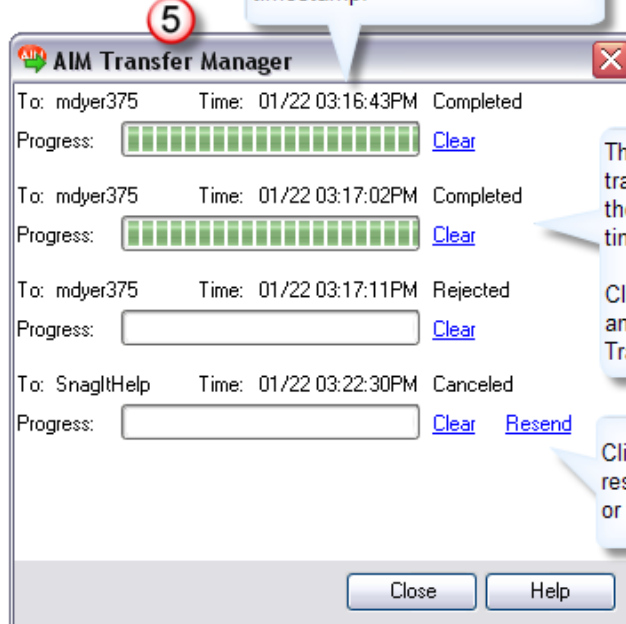
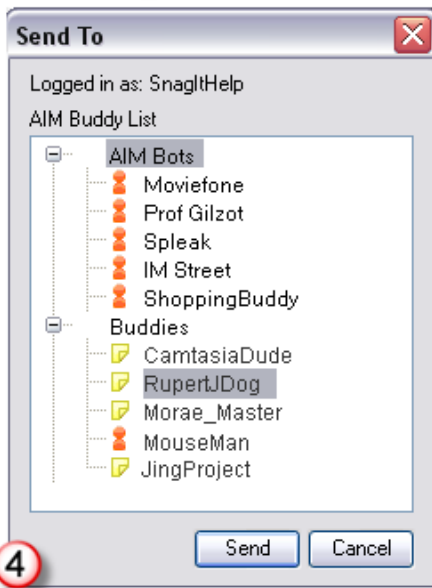
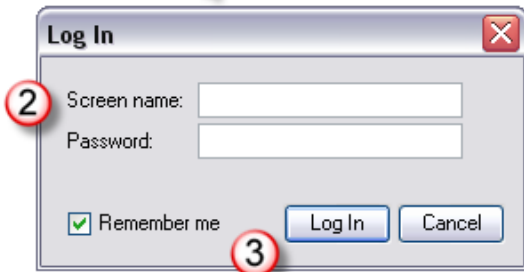

Use the AOL Instant Messenger Output

In SnagIt, configure and take a capture. Make any edits or annotations.

To send a PNG file of a capture to an AIM contact:

- 1 Click the AIM output icon.
- 2 Enter your AIM login information.
- 3 Check the **Remember me** option to always use this AIM screen name. Click **Log In**.
- 4 The *Send To* dialog box appears. Select a contact from your Buddy List to receive the file and click **Send**.
- 5 The *Transfer Manager* window opens and your buddy is notified you want to send a file. If they accept, your file is transferred.



Each transfer displays your selected buddy's name, date and timestamp.

The status of your transfer displays to the right of the timestamp.
Click **Clear** to remove an item from the Transfer Manager list.

Click **Resend** to resend canceled or failed transfers.
