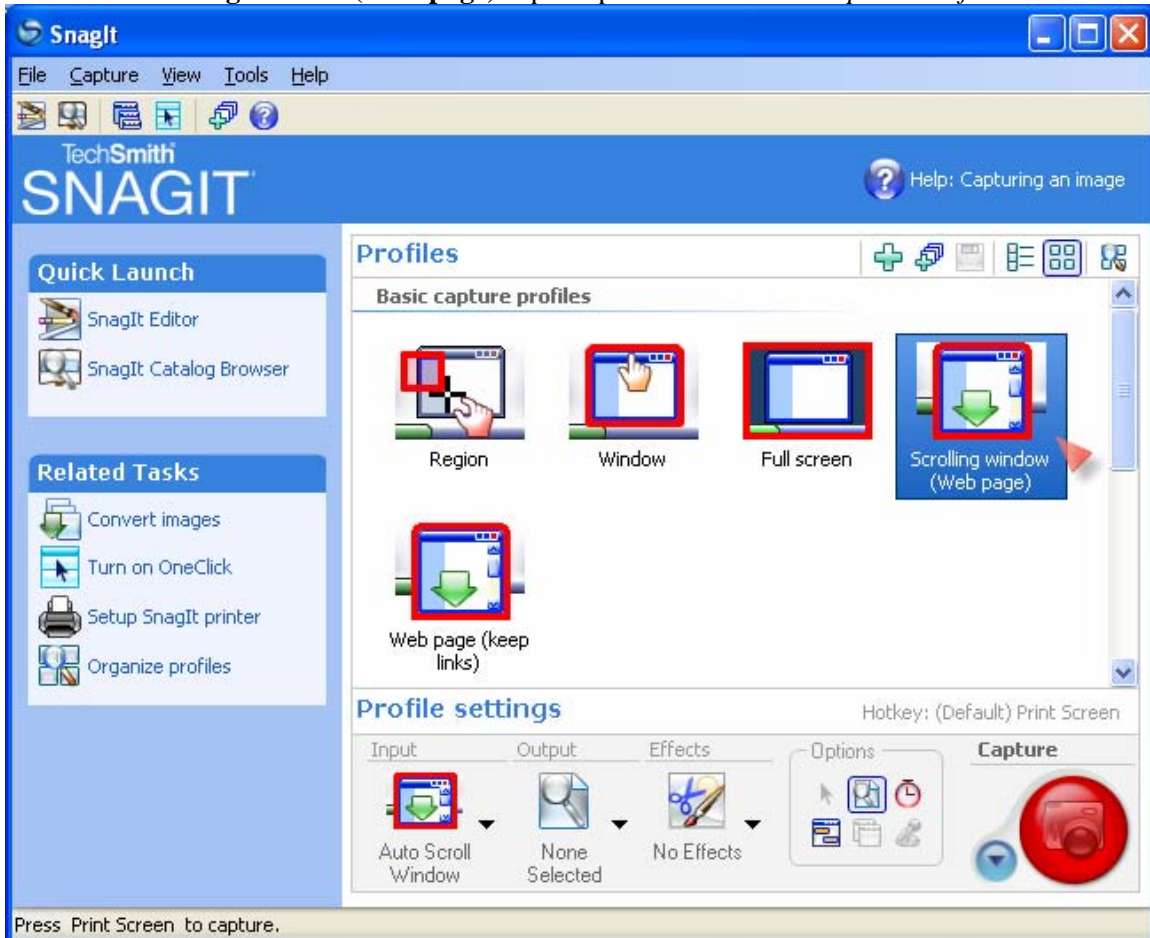


Capture a Long Web Page with Auto Scroll

Taking a capture of a long Web page (or other long window) is easy using *SnagIt's Auto Scroll* feature. Use the following procedure to quickly and easily capture a Web page:


1. Make sure that the Web page that you want to capture is open in your internet browser on your computer desktop.
2. Without minimizing your internet browser, open *SnagIt*.
3. Select the **Scrolling window (Web page)** capture profile from *Basic capture Profiles*.



4. Click **Capture**.



The *SnagIt* window disappears, and you see the Web page and a finger pointer cursor with a page icon

attached to it. 

5. Left-click once in the middle of the window to start the capture.

6. Wait while the window scrolls automatically. (To cancel, right-click or press <ESC>.)
Note: Clicking the left mouse button a second time stops the capture prematurely and only captures part of the page.
7. When complete, the capture appears in the *Capture Preview* window.
8. Click an output on the *Output Options* toolbar.



9. Click **Done** to close the *Capture Preview* window.
